This month Pete tests out a set of Big Wipes from Sycamore hoping he can treat his hands mean and still get them clean.



eeping our hands clean is a constant battle. The use of latex gloves in more recent years certainly helps.
But they're not always

practical and can become a nuisance. So getting your hands dirty is part and parcel of the job. This causes problems, particularly if you are in the middle of a job and the phone rings — of course you need to answer it — it could be someone wanting to look at a fleet of motors for servicing for the next six months. But your hands are filthy and you don't want to get your phone in the same state. You don't have time to wash your pinkies or

the phone will stop and you've lost your contract. What you need is a tub of industrial hand wipes so I was happy to take some Big Wipes on test. The wipe is two-sided, a scrub face for extra fast grime removal and a smooth face for soaking up the dirt.

Put to the test they certainly did the job at hand. The wipes are soaked in a cleaning agent in the tub and always come out moist to aid the cleaning process.
