### Salus expands range of wireless heating controls

A new range of electronic radio frequency (RF) wireless heating controls from SALUS has been launched, the ERT20RF and ERT20TX. These models separate the operating functions into two units - receiver and thermostat.

Designed to replace residential thermostats and for use with electric, gas or oil heating control systems, both ERT20RF and ERT20TX comprise a separate receiver that is used for switching the boiler on and off, together with a thermostat for the user interface and temperature sensing control. While a 16 amp receiver comes as standard with the ERT20RF, it may be purchased separately for the ERT20TX, allowing choice and flexibility.



The two separate units are linked together by an RF signal and are able to interact with each other. Both models boast an accurate dial thermostat, designed for use in both Volt Free and AC heating applications, and feature LED indication. Requiring no external power supply. RF thermostats may be wall-mounted in any appropriate temperature sensing location, up to 60 metres away from its receiver.



## VADO upgrades its thermostatic valves

VADO has upgraded its thermostatic valves. All VADO thermostatic valves now have a new polymer cartridge fitted as standard.

The cartridge prevents limescale build up, reducing maintenance and increasing the life span of the valve VADO has also created two new valve designs to complement the popular Phase and Photon ranges, as well as reducing the size of the Notion and Mix valve faceplates.

The Celsius square valve faceplates have a new look too, they now feature smaller plates with rounded corners. Re-designed mortar guards, which now feature markings to aid installation and tiling, complete the upgrade.
